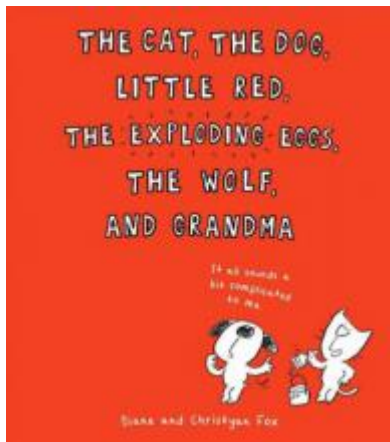
The Eighth Day by Dianne K. Salerni

The Cat, the Dog, Little Red, the Exploding Eggs, the Wolf and Grandma by Diane Fox, Christyan Fox

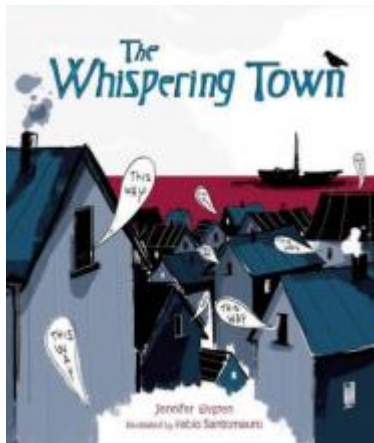
Reading Level: Ages 3 - 8
