

Roku Lending Policy

Purpose: Roku streaming devices are available to Highland Park Public Library cardholders (ages 14 and older) so that they may stream popular TV shows and movies.

Limitations: Wi-Fi connection and a HDTV with a HDMI port are required to use a Roku streaming device. Each Roku is preloaded with selected accounts and content, in accordance with Library collection policies.

Use: The following rules and regulations apply:

- 1. Roku streaming devices may be borrowed by Highland Park Public Library cardholders ages 14 and older in good standing.
- 2. The loan period is 7 days with 1 renewal.
- 3. Roku players must be returned directly to a staff person at the Film & Music desk. They must not be returned in the book drop or to another library.
- 4. Borrowers may not download or delete any titles, accounts, or content from the Roku player.
- 5. The library is not responsible for damage to the borrower's personal devices or equipment.
- 6. The borrower is responsible for returning all Roku parts in good condition. Failure to return an item will result in the following costs charged to the account:
 - a. Roku Streaming Stick + \$60
 - b. Power adapter & extender cable \$14
 - c. Remote \$15
 - d. USB Power Cable with Advanced Wireless Receiver \$20
 - e. Case \$6
